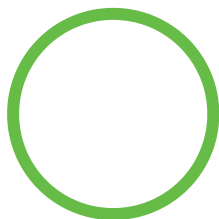

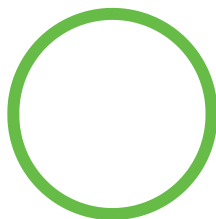

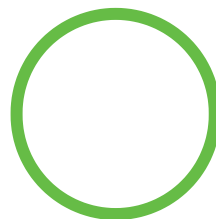
Preparation

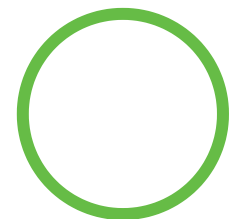
Clarity
